Foundation Course

Project: Jewellery Box

Cost: R4000 + R500 Once off Registration Fee

Duration: 6 Classes of 4 Hours Each

Introduction to Woodworking. We cover the cut list; differentiate between manmade boards and hard wood. Student will work with all the power tools; surfacers, thicknessers, table saw, and various handheld powertools as well as stain and paint techniques.

Intermediate Course

Project: CD/DVD Cabinet

Cost: R6560 + R1400 for Timber

Duration: 12 Classes of 4 Hours Each

Project can be different as long as the techniques remain the same as the curriculum. Techniques taught in this course – laminating timber together using F or glue joints, stopped running dovetails, mortise and tennon joints, box or finger joints, handmade drawer runners to name a few. Project will be stained if necessary and sprayed using a water base vanish.

Advanced Course

Project: Ladies Writing Desk

Cost: R8350 + R2280 for Timber

Duration: 12 Classes of 4 Hours Each

Project can differ as long as the curriculum of the course is followed. The student does a lot more here and will be working harder doing dovetails of all kinds, half blind, lock,

sliding dovetails. Student will do fine polishing and unit will be coated in Danish Oil.

Woodturning 1

Project: Lampshade and Bowl

Cost: R 5650

Duration: 6 Classes of 4 Hours Each

Student will be taught the name and uses of the different woodturning chisels and gouges as well as accessories. Sharpening and holding of chisels using different tools and methods. We do both spindle turning as well as faceplate and chuck turning. Projects will be sanding and polished.

Woodturning 2

Project: Coffee Table and Writing Pen

Cost: R 5650

Duration: 6 Classes of 4 Hours Each

Student will do only spindle turning in this course, however duplicating turnings using aids as well as the copying attachment to be done. We will do the setup and sharpening as well as the producing and designing of template both 2 and 3 dimensional templates.

Kitchen and B.I.C Course

Project: Floor-Drawer & Wall Units

Cost: R 9800

Duration: 10 Classes of 4 Hours Each

We start from the beginning by differentiating the man made boards. The standards of the floor units, the wall units as well as the tall wall units. We work out the basic designs and cutting lists. In this course we also make our own doors in

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solid timber using the rail and style cutters and the raised panel cutter.

We work a lot with the router, making jigs and templates. Costing and quotes worked out by the students are exercised with plans given, in order to facilitate speedy and effective service to clients. BIC are designed and done on a smaller scale. Installation of units done and practiced cut out of hob's and zinc's done as well as edging using pre-glued and Formica.

Finishing Carpentry

Project: Hanging of doors etc

Cost: R 6500

Duration: 8 Classes of 4 Hours Each

Finishing Carpentry is the art of making a house a home. In this course we teach the student the different types of doors available on the market as well as the standards. We hang a hollow core door on both a steel and wooden frame. We practice the hanging of a stable, arch, and a pivot door. We make and install skirting, plinth blocks, dado rails and cornice on a model. We do training on the relevant power tools to speed up the actual hanging of doors.

Children's Classes

Project: Various

Cost: R 130 per child

Duration: 1 Classes of 2 Hours Each

We offer children courses on Wednesdays and Saturdays. All children from 4 years and up are welcome to join. The projects differ depending on the age groups. We make it fun and learnable for all the children and even the parents.

The Maximum Student we can accommodate is 4 People per Course.
